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# Introduction

## Background

The Education Workforce Council is the independent regulator in Wales for:

School teachers	Since 2001
FE teachers (lecturers)	Since April 2015
School and FE learning support workers	Since April 2016
Work-based learning practitioners	Since April 2017
Qualified youth and youth support workers	Since April 2017

The Council was established by the Education (Wales) Act 2014. Under the Act, the General Teaching Council for Wales (GTCW) was reconfigured and renamed to become the Education Workforce Council (EWC).

We aim to contribute to improving standards of teaching and the quality of learning in Wales as well as maintaining and improving standards of professional conduct amongst teachers and persons who support teaching and learning in the interests of learners, parents and the public.

Regulations require a practitioner to be registered in the correct category or categories for the work that they undertake or intend to undertake. More information is available at [www.ewc.wales](http://www.ewc.wales) “Applying for registration”.

Practitioners may be registered in multiple categories if they are working or intend to work in more than one registrant category.

## Introduction to this Digest

The Annual Statistics Digest has been produced from the EWC Register of Education Practitioners and the information that we are able to hold on the Register is set out in the Education Workforce Council (Main Functions) (Wales) Regulations 2015, as amended. Further information and our privacy notice are available at [www.ewc.wales](http://www.ewc.wales).

The Register is real time and provides a unique source of data not available elsewhere. The criteria used to produce the digest differ from other information sources, such as those published by the Department for Education and the Welsh Government.

Previous copies of our Statistics Digest (dating back to March 2002) are available to download from our website [www.ewc.wales](http://www.ewc.wales) if required.

It is important to note that the digest contains data based on the following criteria:

- Registrant numbers are recorded as actuals, rather than full-time equivalent;
- Barring the all registrant section (section 1) which indicates the number of individuals on the Register, practitioners registered in multiple categories e.g. school and FE teacher, are included in all relevant sections. The ability to register in more than one category commenced from April 2015 due to changing legislation. Prior to this date individuals were only able to register as a school teacher;
- Where a registrant has more than one employment record on the Register e.g. school teacher in a school and an FE teacher in a college, the employment information in section 2 is derived from the school employment record and in section 4 the employment is derived from the FE employment record. In all sections, there are registered practitioners who may not be working but have chosen to register with their professional body;
- Supply registrants are counted once only in each section regardless of the number of employers they may work for;
- The census date used for the data taken from the Register is 1 March each year;
- The information recorded on the Register is obtained and subsequently updated by the employer or directly from the registrant;
- The Council worked with employers to register their existing staff “en masse” to establish the Register for each group. The Council only required a minimal amount of data on each practitioner to complete the initial registration. Since this time, practitioners have been further populating their records and any new registrants have been required to provide full information. Data is more complete for certain registration groups e.g. school teachers due to initial registration dates and mandatory qualification requirements, therefore the data characteristics differ in each section depending on the level of population. The Council is undertaking a programme of work to continue to populate records of the newer registrant groups and will publish more specific data as records become more complete;
- Percentages may not total 100 due to rounding.

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## 1. All registrants

As at 1 March 2019, there were 80,172 individual registrants on the EWC Register of Educational Practitioners. Registrants are able to register in one or more of the following categories:

- School teacher
- School learning support worker
- FE teacher
- FE learning support worker
- Work-based learning practitioner
- Qualified youth worker
- Qualified youth support worker

\*Of those who are registered in multiple categories, 6,874 practitioners are registered in 2 categories, 698 are registered in 3 categories, 274 are registered in 4 categories, 42 are registered in 5 categories and 1 is registered in 6 categories.

\*\*All subsequent sections (section 2 to 8) are based on the number of registrants eligible to practise in each category. Individuals registered in multiple categories are counted in each applicable category i.e. if a school teacher is also registered as a school learning support worker and FE teacher they will be counted in all relevant sections as they are eligible to work or may be working (if part time) in all three categories.











## 5.8 Number of further education learning support workers registered with EWC by ability to speak Welsh





## 9. Data definitions and assumptions

- The data contained in this Digest is based on a number of specific criteria. The following assumptions apply to all tables in the report:
  - All data in this report includes Education Workforce Council (EWC) registrants;
  - Supply registrants in each section are only counted once regardless of the number of employers they undertake supply work for.
- As previously indicated the census date used for the data taken from the Register is 1 March each year. For the 2018 and 2019 digest the data produced in respect of employment is based on information extracted from the Register in May following the fee renewal process to ensure the most complete information.
- In considering the data it should be noted that there is no legal obligation for registrants or employers to notify EWC of the posts within their setting.
- The following definitions apply to the relevant tables:
