GTCW Data Analysis of NPQH Holders - August 2013

Data taken from the Register of Qualified Teachers on 1st March 2013

General Notes

- Total number of registered teachers with NPQH is 1,756 (headteachers; 891, Others; 865);
- Headteachers are NOT included in tables 2-11 but ARE included in table 1 and tables 12-14;
- The registered teacher numbers are displayed as "actuals" rather than "full-time equivalents;"
- The number of registered teachers is "real-time" and can go up or down depending on new registrations and de-registrations;
- All data relates to the first current employment held on a teacher's record regardless of whether they are employed by more than one employer;
- The below figures include teachers registered with GTCW who gained NPQH in Wales or in England;
- There are a number of teachers who gained NPQH in Wales and who are not working in Wales and are not therefore registered with GTCW.

In considering tables 7, 8 & 9 please note that GTCW records Welsh language data for those teachers registered with us.

- When making an application for registration or amending a registered teacher record, teachers are advised to consider the following criteria in respect of the question:
 - Able to teach through the medium of Welsh: answer "Yes" if they were trained to teach, currently teach, have ever taught pupils through the medium of Welsh or feel confident to do so.
- Some registered teachers do not provide this information and the relevant fields in their record on the Council's Register are marked as "Unknown".
- The split of Welsh medium and English medium schools are as defined from the Welsh Government's address list of schools in Wales.

Key Findings

- Table 1 shows the split of registered headteachers with and without NPQH as at the 1st March 2013. A high percentage (45%) of current headteachers do not hold NPQH although this is improving given that NPQH is mandatory for newly appointed headteachers;
- Of the number of registered teachers (not Headteachers) with NPQH, 62% are female compared with 38% of males. When one considers that the gender split of headteachers is 43% male and 57% female (Annual Stats Digest 2013) and the split of all registered teachers is 25% male and 75% female, there is an evident overrepresentation of male headteachers in current posts as well as with NPQH holders who are not headteachers;
- 318 registered teachers (not Headteachers) are not in a senior position but hold NPQH. Of those, 220 gained NPQH five or more years ago. This suggests that of the total number of registered teachers (not headteachers) with NPQH, 25% are unlikely to be considered for a Headteacher post;
- Of the number of registered teachers (not Headteachers) with NPQH, none have declared a disability. Given that only 0.3% of the total Register have made a declaration regarding their disability and approximately 8% of the UK population have declared a disability it suggests that the number of registered teachers with a declared disability is under represented on the Register;
- Of the total number of registered teachers (not headteachers) with NPQH, 216 (25%) are able to teach through the medium of Welsh and 121 (56%) of those currently teach in a Welsh medium school. By comparison, 42% of registered headteachers have declared that they are Welsh speakers with 37% able to teach through the medium of Welsh and 32.5% of all registered teachers are declared Welsh speakers with 27% being able to teach through the medium of Welsh. These percentages have remained level for a number of years. When compared to the 2011 Census on the Welsh Language where 19% of the population were recorded as Welsh speakers, an 8.6% drop when compared to the census of 2001, it is evident that the Welsh Language provision within the teaching profession remains consistently above the national level in Wales;

- 12.4% of all registered teaches have failed to make a declaration regarding their ethnicity. Of the 865 registered teachers (not headteachers) with NPQH 192 (22%) have not declared an ethnicity. Of those teachers with NPQH who have made a declaration, 96% have described themselves as either White:British or White:Any other white background. This percentage is similar to the overall number of registered teachers who have made an ethnicity declaration (97% White:British or White:Any other white background);
- 203 (23.5%) registered teachers (not headteachers) who hold NPQH are aged 55 or over. Given that the percentage of headteachers aged over 50 has declined over the last 2-3 years it is questionable whether these individuals would be appointed to a headship post;
- 87 (10%) registered teachers (not headteachers) with NPQH work within Cardiff LA which is consistent with them being one of the largest authorities in Wales, 69 (79%) of the 87 are already in deputy or assistant headteacher positions. Isle of Anglesey and Merthyr Tydfil have the lowest number of registered teachers (not headteachers) with NPQH at 13 and 12 respectively however 11 of the 12 in Merthyr are currently in deputy or assistant headteacher positions where as, in the Isle of Anglesey only 7 (53%) of the registered teachers (not headteachers) with NPQH are in a senior role currently;
- The ratio of registered teachers (not headteachers) with NPQH compared to those without in the primary sector is 3% and 2.3% in the secondary sector.
