For teachers trained in Northern Ireland or teachers who hold full registration with the General Teaching Council for Northern Ireland

Guidance notes

Recognition as a Teacher in Wales

Recognition as a qualified teacher in Wales is governed by The School Teachers' Qualifications (Wales) Regulations 2012 and Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) is an accreditation made to those teachers who meet the professional standards required for employment as a qualified teacher in Wales.

In accordance with the Regulations, all persons who have successfully completed a course of initial teacher education at an educational institution in Northern Ireland or who have full registration status with the General Teaching Council for Northern Ireland (GTCNI) can be awarded Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) in Wales.

Legislation also requires all qualified teachers (those with QTS) who wish to undertake the "specified work" of a teacher in maintained schools or non-maintained special schools in Wales to be registered with the EWC before commencing work.

How to complete this form

Please complete all relevant fields and sign and date the form where indicated.

If you have successfully completed a teacher training course at an institution in Northern Ireland but **do not** have recognition from GTCNI you should forward the completed form to your training institution for endorsement.

If you have been awarded confirmation of recognition as a teacher in schools in Northern Ireland please forward the form for endorsement to:

What happens next?

As soon as your endorsed QTS application form is returned to us we will assess it against the regulations and will respond to the application within 15 working days from the receipt of a completed application form.

If QTS is awarded we will allocate a teacher reference number to you (if you do not already hold one) and write to you enclosing your QTS certificate. We will also provide you with an application pack in order that you can apply for registration with us.

If QTS is not awarded we will write to you detailing the reasons why and requesting additional information if relevant.

Induction

From 1st September 2003 newly qualified teachers in Wales are required to satisfactorily complete a statutory Induction period. However the following exemptions apply:

- if you qualified as a teacher in Northern Ireland on or before 1st
 April 2003 you will be exempt from the Induction requirement in Wales.
- If you successfully completed the required induction period in Northern Ireland

In this case you must provide the GTCW with a copy of your letter from the Education & Library Board which confirms successful completion of the Induction programme in Northern Ireland.

Not trained in Northern Ireland

If you are a teacher in an overseas country who is registered with GTCNI, in addition to any requirements under the induction section above, you will also need to provide evidence of a period of practical teaching of at least 60 days at an educational institution in Northern Ireland.

Please include the name and address of the school / institution , the name of the Headteacher and your employment start and end dates.

In your practical teaching was undertaken in more than one establishment, please provide the details for each one.

Please note that any individual who trained in a country other than Northern Ireland and who is **not** registered with GTCNI is **not** eligible to apply for QTS recognition in Wales.
